

## Using Classes

The HTML `class` attribute is used to create a style that can be used on any element. It can give your webpage a uniform look. Here are three examples that use classes:

```
.note {  
  font-size: 120%;  
  color: red;  
}
```

This code can be used with `<span></span>` to change the color and size of text.

```
.banner {  
  background-color:  
SlateBlue;  
  color: white;  
  padding: 10px;  
}
```

This code creates a colored banner across the page and turns the text white. It can be used with any heading or paragraph text.

```
.box {  
  background-color:  
DeepPink;  
  color: white;  
  border: 2px solid black;  
  margin: 20px;  
  padding: 20px;  
}  
</style>
```

This code can be used with a `<div></div>` section to create a colored block with a border.

## Bookmarks

HTML bookmarks are used to allow readers to jump to specific parts of a webpage.

Bookmarks can be useful if your page is very long.

To use a bookmark, you must first create an id ( `id="here"` ),  
and then add a link to it `<a href="#here">Go to Here</a>`.

Then, when the link is clicked, the page will scroll to the location with the bookmark.

Add this line to the very top of the body of your Day4 page.

```
<p><a href="#last">Go to the Bottom of the Page</a></p>
```

Add this line to the bottom of the body section, right before the `</body>` tag.

```
<h2 id="last">This is the bottom of the page!</h2>
```
