

# Making a Table

Start, End a Table	<code>&lt;table style="width:100%"&gt;</code>	<code>&lt;/table&gt;</code>
Specifies row location	<code>&lt;tr&gt;</code>	<code>&lt;/tr&gt;</code>
Specifies table headings	<code>&lt;th&gt;</code>	<code>&lt;/th&gt;</code>
Specifies table data	<code>&lt;td&gt;</code>	<code>&lt;/td&gt;</code>

Example:

```
<table style="width:100%">
  <tr>
    <th>First Name</th>
    <th>Last Name</th>
    <th>Age</th>
  </tr>
  <tr>
    <td>Jill</td>
    <td>Smith</td>
    <td>50</td>
  </tr>
  <tr>
    <td>Eve</td>
    <td>Jackson</td>
    <td>94</td>
  </tr>
</table>
```

This code makes a table that looks like this:

First Name	Last Name	Age
Jill	Smith	50
Eve	Jackson	94

To add a border, include this code in the style section of the header:

```
table, th, td {
  border: 1px solid black;
  border-collapse: collapse;
}
```

You can also make **dotted** or **dashed** lines.

To make rounded borders around each cell, add this to the style section of the header:

```
th, td {
  border: 1px solid black;
  border-radius: 10px;
}
```


To add extra spacing around the text in each cell, add this to the style section of the header:

```
th, td {
  padding: 15px;
}
```

To align the text in each cell (left, right, or center), add this to the style section of the header:

```
th {  
  text-align: left;  
}
```

To color the cells of the table, add this to the style section header:

```
th, td {  
  background-color: _____;  write the name or code of the color  
}
```

To change the width of a column, add a style tag to the header of the column, like this:

```
<th style="width:70%">Firstname</th>
```

To change the height of a row, add a style tag to the row, like this:

```
<tr style="height:200px">
```

To add horizontal lines under each row, add this to the style section of the header

```
table {  
  border-collapse: collapse;  
  width: 100%;  
}  
  
tr {  
  border-bottom: 1px solid #ddd;  
}
```

# Lists

## Unordered List

```
<ul>
  <li>Banana </li>
  <li>Apple </li>
  <li>Pineapple </li>
</ul>
```

- Banana
- Apple
- Pineapple

Change from disc to circle or square or none  
<ul style="list-style-type:disc"> or circle or square or none

## Ordered List

```
<ol>
  <li>First </li>
  <li>Second </li>
  <li>Third </li>
</ol>
```

1. First
2. Second
3. Third

Change the type of numbering:

The **type** attribute of the <ol> tag, defines the type of the list item marker:

Type	Description
type="1"	The list items will be numbered with numbers (default)
type="A"	The list items will be numbered with uppercase letters
type="a"	The list items will be numbered with lowercase letters
type="I"	The list items will be numbered with uppercase roman numbers
type="i"	The list items will be numbered with lowercase roman numbers
