Parents Need to Make Sure Your Student:

- Is attending class or watching class videos
- Is turning in homework on time, before the test
- Has the textbooks and supplies needed for class

High School Honors/AP Classes

Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Anatomy, Calculus, World History, and Literature can be taken as honors classes. Honors students do more work and are better prepared for college. Let me know by the second week of September if your student would like to take an honors level class.

Friday Tutoring

On most Fridays, I have one-on-one tutoring from 2 – 5 pm at my house. Students can drop by to work on homework or test corrections.

Extra Credit

There are two ways your student can earn extra credit:

Test Corrections

SAT Vocabulary Cards (For math and science classes)

Attendance/Missing Classes

All classes meet in person. Students who cannot attend class can Skype occasionally. Students who cannot Skype can watch the class video. Assignments are still due at their regular time.

Skyping

For your student's Skype account, please use your name or your student's name for the account, not a nickname. You or your student needs to send me a contact request or "wave" on Skype. Once I have them in my contacts, I can add them to a class call. If the class call has started, I cannot add someone to the call unless I already have them in my contact list. Your student must have a working microphone if they Skype.

Turning in Assignments

Most assignments are due at the class following the one when they were assigned. Homework should be written by hand on notebook paper, unless otherwise specified. The student's name must be on the assignment and the writing must be legible. Assignments cannot be emailed or sent by text.

Tests

Tests are taken in person during the regular class time. Tests are not timed, and students can have additional time to finish a test. If your student is not able to take a test when it is scheduled, please contact me about scheduling a time when they can take it.

Gradebook

I usually update the grades on the weekend. The best time for you to check your student's grades is Monday morning. I do not use the colored dot system on the app; please ignore the dots.

Missing = It was not turned in when it was due, but your student can still turn it in.

Late = It was turned in on the day of the test and it will be graded by the end of the semester.

Blank = It was not turned in before the test and there is no grade.

"No grade" is not a zero. It does not bring your student's average down. Your student is allowed two "no grade" homework grades each semester. After that, missing homework will be given a zero.

Gradebook Notifications

If you go into Settings on Jupiter Ed, you can have the program text or email you anytime I mark an assignment missing. This lets you know that your student didn't turn in an assignment, but can still turn it in for credit.

Tuition

Tuition is due on the first class day of each month. I will email you an invoice on the 20th of each month. You can pay online or by cash or check. If you'd like to pay for by the semester, let me know.

Behavior in Class

Respect people. Respect property. No phones out in the classroom.

Parking

Park on my side of the street. Pull as far off the street as you can. Do not park on my neighbor's yard. Do not drive around the neighborhood. Turn around and exit the way you came in.

You can access your student's final semester grades on Jupiter Ed. If you use an umbrella program and need an official grade letter from me, let me know.
